FIREWORKS AT DUSK

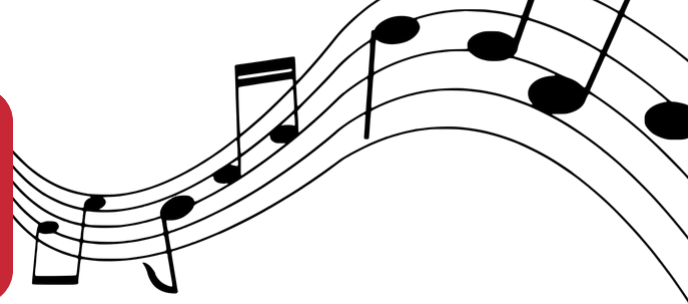
As the sun sets, look to the sky for a fireworks display over the park. Please supervise children, respect safety boundaries, and be considerate of pets and fellow campers during the show.

Official Rules & Information

1. Event Date: August 16th, 2026, at SRBP Beach.
2. Registration is free and available at the SRBP Office.
3. Participants may enter individually or as a team.
4. Families, friends, and group participation are encouraged.
5. All participants must meet on the Shoreline Patio prior to the start of the event. (9:45 AM)
No participant shall begin building before the horn sounds.
6. The competition will begin at 10:00 AM when the horn sounds.
7. All sand castles and sculptures must be completed by 12:00 PM.
8. Judging will take place immediately following the competition.
9. Prizes will be awarded for 1st Place, 2nd Place, and 3rd Place.
10. Participants may use buckets, shovels, and hand tools. No powered equipment or pre-built structures are permitted.
11. Sand castles must be family-friendly and appropriate for a public event.
12. Once judging and event photos are complete, participants are asked to return the beach area to its natural condition by flattening and leveling the sand so all campers and visitors can continue to safely enjoy the public beach.
13. Steep Rock Beach Park reserves the right to modify event details or cancel the event due to weather or safety concerns.

OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Steep Rock Beach Park Marina

Licensing & General Requirements

1. All anglers must possess a valid Manitoba Fishing Licence where required by provincial law.
2. All Manitoba and Canadian fishing regulations must be followed at all times.
3. The Summer Solstice Fishing Derby is intended to promote safe, respectful, and family-friendly fishing within Steep Rock Beach Park Marina.
4. Derby participants are responsible for understanding catch limits, size restrictions, and protected species regulations.
5. Unsportsmanlike conduct, intoxication causing disruption, harassment, or unsafe behaviour may result in immediate disqualification and removal from the event area.
6. The Derby Committee reserves the right to refuse participation to anyone not complying with rules, safety expectations, or park regulations.

Event Schedule

1. Registration Opens: May 15th
2. Fishing Begins: 10:00 AM (June 21, 2026)
3. Fishing Ends: 1:00 PM (June 21, 2026)
4. All fish entered must be caught within the official derby hours.

Entry, Tickets & Access

1. Each registered participant must have their Summer Solstice Fishing Derby ticket while participating.
2. Participants may fish from shore, dock, or off a boat with permission from the registered boat owner within designated derby boundaries.
3. Spectators are welcome; however, only registered participants may enter fish into the competition.
4. Tickets are non-refundable unless the organizers cancel the event.

Fishing Rules

1. Only fish caught within the designated Steep Rock Beach Park Marina derby area are eligible.
2. Participants may fish using a maximum of one rod at a time.
3. No snagging, netting, or intentional foul-hooking of fish is permitted.
4. Artificial bait and lures are permitted unless otherwise announced before the event. No barbed hooks are permitted.
5. Fish must be caught fairly during derby hours and by the registered participant entering the fish.
6. Participants are expected to maintain respectful spacing between anglers.

OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS - CONTINUED...

Registration

1. All participants must be under the age of 17. The registration fee is \$10.00 and can be paid in advance at the SRBP Office before June 21, 2026. Each participant will receive a pass for the derby and must present it at the event.

Boat & Marina Safety Rules

1. No participant should be fishing off any boat without the permission of the registered boat owner.

Fish Handling, Measuring & Prizes

1. Eligible species for prizes: Northern Pike (Jack), Suckers, Perch, and Pickerel.
2. All fish must be presented to derby officials immediately for measuring or weighing.
3. Measurements and weigh-ins will be conducted only at the official derby station using official measuring devices.
4. Fish must comply with Manitoba conservation regulations and legal size requirements, use barbless hooks, and no live bait is permitted.
5. In the event of a tie, the first fish recorded will receive the higher placing.
6. Only one major prize may be awarded per participant unless otherwise announced.
7. Fish deemed altered, tampered with, frozen, or previously caught will be disqualified.
8. Prize payouts will be distributed from the total registration prize pool as follows: 1st Place will receive 50% of the total prize pool, 2nd Place will receive 30%, and 3rd Place will receive 20%. An additional prize will also be awarded for the heaviest fish caught during the derby.

Environmental Responsibility

1. Participants must keep the marina and park clean at all times.
2. No garbage, fishing line, hooks, bait containers, or fish remains may be left behind.
3. Respect all wildlife, docks, vegetation, and marina property.
4. Catch-and-release practices are strongly encouraged where appropriate.

Weather, Safety & Cancellations

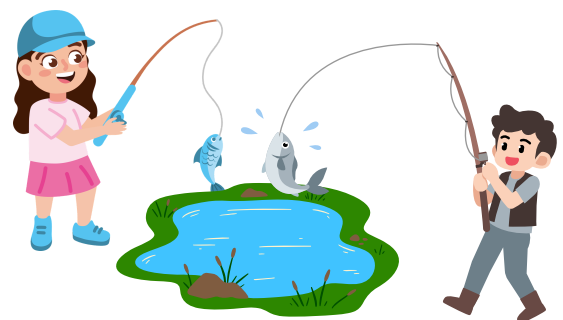
1. The Derby Committee reserves the right to delay, shorten, modify, or cancel the event due to weather or safety concerns.
2. Participants acknowledge that fishing and boating activities involve inherent risks. Participation is at their own risk.
3. Emergency or safety instructions from derby officials, park staff, or emergency personnel must be followed immediately.

Compliance

1. Failure to comply with derby rules may result in warnings, disqualification, removal from the event area, or forfeiture of prizes.
2. By participating in the derby, participants consent to event photography and promotional use of images by Steep Rock Beach Park unless otherwise requested.
