

Information for Park Visitors

Provincial Response Level: RESTRICTED

Steep Rock Beach Park must adhere to current public health orders.

Camping & Group Use Sites: Only one household may occupy a cabin. Multiple households may camp at a campsite together, however persons must not occupy a tent or trailer together unless they normally reside at the same private residence. A maximum of six people may occupy a campsite under regular camping regulations. Or 25 in a group site with 5 tents. Up to 10 visitors may attend your site during visiting hours (9 a.m. – 11 p.m.) but can not stay overnight.

Beaches, Playgrounds & Picnic Areas: Follow physical distancing requirements and do not share towels, blankets, toys, food or other items with people outside your household. Keep children within arms reach. Playground equipment is not cleaned or sanitized – wash/sanitize hands before and after use

Park Store is limited to only three visitors and only 1 member of a family at a time and face masks must be worn. Please observe signage and queue two metres away from others outside if required. Visitors may be required to provide name and contact information in order for public health officials to alert you in the event you have been exposed to COVID-19 while visiting the facility.

Out-of-province visitors may not self-isolate in the campground.

Only visit local health centres if it is an emergency.

- **Practice physical distancing. Keep two metres away from anyone not in your household.**
- **Outdoor gatherings are restricted to 25 people. This includes beaches, trails and all public areas in parks.**
- **Face masks must be worn while inside all buildings including washrooms, laundry rooms, store and cafe.**
- **Wash your hands or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer regularly.**
- **Stay home when sick. Do not visit if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 or if you or someone in your household are required to self-isolate.**
