## Information for Park Visitors

Updated May 21, 2021



Provincial Response Level: CRITICAL Steep Rock Beach Park visitors must adhere to current public health orders.

**Camping:** Campsites are considered a temporary place of accommodation, and are restricted to members from one household per campsite.

**Group Use Sites:** Group sites will be divided into 5 separate areas. 1 tent per area and restricted to members from one household per area. Each area will have a firepit and a picnic table provided. **Beaches, Playgrounds & Picnic Areas:** Follow physical distancing requirements and do not share towels, blankets, toys, food or other items with people outside your household. Keep children within arms reach. Playground equipment is not cleaned or sanitized – wash/sanitize hands before and after use

**Park Store** is limited to only three visitors and only 1 member of a family at a time and face masks must be worn. Please observe signage and queue two metres away from others outside if required. Visitors may be required to provide name and contact information in order for public health officials to alert you in the event you have been exposed to COVID-19 while visiting the facility.

Out-of-province visitors may not self-isolate in the campground. Only visit local health centres if it is an emergency.

- Practice physical distancing. Keep two metres away from anyone not in your household.
- Gathering sizes are restricted to members of the same household in outdoor spaces.
- Face masks must be worn while inside all buildings including washrooms, laundry rooms, store and cafe.
- Wash your hands or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer regularly.
- Stay home when sick. Do not visit if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 or if you or someone in your household are required to self-isolate.
